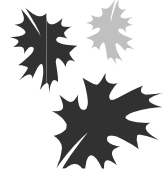

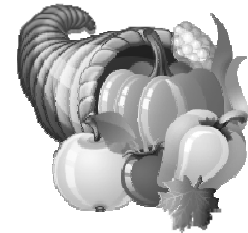

CROP Walk

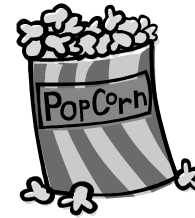
Sunday, October 16, 2011 at 2:30P
